Agency for Persons with Disabilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • APD-licensed group homes, are restricting visitors in compliance with the Executive Order to protect the health and safety of our customers. • APD Adult Day Training programs are screening visitors for possible exposure to COVID-19 using a visitor questionnaire. The questionnaire is also being used to screen visitors coming into APD Regional Offices. • Waiver Support Coordinators will interact via technology
All Souls Food Pantry	Reduced hours. Open Wednesday, 9-10:30 a.m.
Angel Wings	We are operating normally and have one space currently with a possible second space in a week or so. Referring agencies can call 239-898-0945. Please note that our target demographic is single women without dependent children, substance abuse issues, or major medical concerns that want to re-enter the workforce and move toward self-sufficiency and independence.
Better Together	We are open and ready to serve! We are being mindful of hostings, asking questions- have they been out of the country in the last two weeks, currently ill, etc, Helping families problem solve.

<p>Cape Vineyard Community Church</p>	<p>Cape Vineyard Community Church will be doing our Thursday night food pantry and dinner church much differently. We will be going drive-thru instead of inside and sit down. From 4:30-6:30pm guests will be able to drive thru our lines in the parking lot behind our church (the club square parking lot) to register and receive free groceries (open to all, once a month) as well as the Harry Chapin Care & Share groceries (open to those who meet the Harry Chapin requirements, once a month). They will also receive a delicious hot meal to-go style for each person in their household (no restrictions, available each week). We invite anyone and everyone in Lee County who needs assistance to come and receive it here, you do not have to go to this church to receive free groceries.</p> <p>We have a large homeless population that depends on breakfast here every Sunday. While we are streaming live services on Sunday and not gathering in large groups, those who show up for breakfast will be given to-go meals.</p> <p>Our office is closed at this time as we are working remotely from home. All correspondence will be responded to. People can request prayer and stay up to date with our services and events by going to capevineyard.com.</p>
<p>Center for Progress & Excellence</p>	<p>Mobile Crisis Staff will work remotely from home to limit COVID-19 Exposure. Staff members WILL continue to respond to all calls through the Crisis Hotline.</p> <p>Dispatch Department are adding 2 additional questions to the Dispatch questionnaire. 1) Is the client experiencing any cold like/flu like symptoms 2) Has the client traveled outside the US within the past 30 days.</p> <p>All calls to the CPE Office will be transferred to the on-call Crisis Hotline.</p> <p>All staff are to utilize telehealth (Doxy Me) to provide mental health services (therapy sessions, service linkage, mentoring, etc)</p>
<p>Community Cooperative</p>	<p>Effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Café is serving To-Go only, hot meal, handed out on the front porch of the café.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fort Myers Beach Outreach is serving bagged To-Go lunch only • Meals On Wheels is still being delivered on a normal schedule. • Mobile Food Pantries remain on same schedule, but we will be delivering pre-bagged food in a drive-thru. No one is to get out of car. Locations are varying slightly due to school closures so the locations will be continually updated on our website and Facebook. • Social Services is triaging clients at the gate. Food pantry, basic needs (ie toiletries & mail). We have pre-packed groceries for market customers. All client meetings will be done via phone. We are not completing any ACCESS applications at this time. • All events, classes, and community partner events onsite and off have been suspended until April 13.
<p>Florida Self-Directed Care</p>	<p>At Florida Self-Directed Care (FLSDC)- related to NAMI Collier’s decision to honor social distancing recommendations- we are still functioning, though remotely. We are making an effort to connect with everyone in our program and still accepting inquiries, with the understanding that meetings will not be face to face until further notice, therefore all support and business is being conducted via phone, mail, and email.</p>
<p>Goodwill Industries of SWFL</p>	<p>Goodwill Services:</p> <p>All job fairs, events and large meetings have been canceled or postponed</p> <p>Our Community Resource Centers (Job-Link) will continue providing services, with the exception of the services we provide as a partner agency in the Cape Coral United Way House, which is anticipated to reopen within the first week in April. Our active, high volume service sites will remain open, but services will be limited to 5 individuals at a time and/or by appointment only. Coordinators will be using a 6-foot personal distancing rule to minimize health risks.</p>

	<p>MicroEnterprise Institute: All classes and graduations have been postponed until the end of the month.</p> <p>Pathways to Opportunity Program: Our Adult Day Training program will be closed as of 3/18/20 with an anticipated reactivation date of 4/1/20.</p> <p>All other programs are operational at this time, however, this is subject to change. Our Department will continue to monitor the situation and follow the guidelines mandated by our contractual, regulatory and state agencies.</p>
Grace Works Unlimited	<p>Grace Works Unlimited has stopped all volunteering at this time. We are working on a partnership to open up a small food pantry for San Carlos Park residents after this weekend. I can update you when we are ready to open.</p>
Harry Chapin Food Bank	<p>Harry Chapin Food Bank is open for operations. We are continuing to support agencies in our network as best we can with limited donations and volunteers.</p> <p>As always, we do not serve individuals directly at our facilities.</p> <p>Senior kit distributions are continuing unchanged. Some distribution sites may close, and timing may shift. Clients should check our website for updates.</p> <p>Our mobile pantries are operating normally right now, with adjustments to protect participants from infection. Mobile pantries will transition soon to a drive-thru model distributing kits of shelf-stable items supplemented with fresh food as available.</p>

I am working remotely but still sending information electronically about our project, speaking with perspective and current partners by phone and continuing enrollments virtually.

<p>SalusCare</p>	<p>COVID-19 screening is being actively utilized at all of our entry points. We have suspended visitation in residential and acute care programs in order to minimize and mitigate exposure to the virus and we continue to suspend use of our conference space at Evans, Ortiz and Cape Coral locations for after-hours groups. The lion’s share of meetings and scheduled gatherings have been moved to a conference call environment. As previously mentioned, we are identifying ways to temporarily reduce our on-campus foot print to protect the staff that are providing care onsite from exposure, as well as patients.</p>
<p>St. Martin de Porres</p>	<p>St. Martin is serving dinners in takeout only containers from 3-6 Monday through Friday. They are distributed outside.</p> <p>The pantry is operating outside with only one individual at a time able to select food handled only by volunteers. No more than 5 can stand together. We will try it this Friday and determine if we will move to pre-packaged bags or not.</p> <p>After school classes are not operating.</p>
<p>St. Matthew’s House</p>	<p>St. Matthew’s House Thrift Stores and Programs are open.</p>
<p>SWFL Free Pain Clinic</p>	<p>At this time, the SWFL Free Pain Clinic is still scheduling appointments for healthy individuals on Tuesdays and Thursdays from noon to 5pm. We do not take walk-ins. 239.307.7107 for appointments and eligibility.</p>
